

Mock Cable Headband

Warm winter ears!

Mock cables decorate a fancy head warmer



Cylinder: 72 slot or size to fit head circumference.

Yarn: Average weight sock yarn to suit cylinder and sizing.

Gauge: 10 rows/1" as pictured.

Set up cylinder as follows: Remove the first needle before the right hash mark (0), leave the next 5 needles in the cylinder (5) seven times. Pattern runs over 43 needles. There are two cables separated by a 5 stitch plain panel and bordered by 5 stitch plain panels. The first and last needles removed are where the headband is folded.



Left side of cylinder → 0 5 0 5 0 5 0 5 0 5 0 5 0 → 1 needle before right hash mark

Any cylinder can be used. Three empty slots and two panels make up each cable. The cables can be made over any number of stitches and rows depending on the result desired.

Knit 250 rows or slightly less than circumference desired. Remove on waste yarn.

Turn inside out and make the mock cables beginning with the first row and ending with the last row.
